With the completion of the first floor and loft area of the worship center in Anáhuac, weekly worship services began on February 14th. Praise God for this long-awaited answer to prayer! In preparation for this first worship service, we distributed flyers door-to-door and handed them out in the town square. Both Pepe, our Deputy Director, and Osvaldo, our Evangelist, as well as our older children, participated in handing out these flyers. Their participation gave us many opportunities to meet and connect with our neighbors in the community. We plan to continue handing out flyers in the town square and door-to-door on an ongoing basis.

Since holding our first worship service, we have been receiving an encouraging number of views of our uploaded services. We hope this online presence will allow those who are not yet comfortable with in-person services in Anahuac to become a part of our church community.

I can only imagine the things God will do through the activities that will take place in this building. In addition to holding Sunday worship services, Osvaldo will soon begin Wednesday and Friday bible studies with members of the community. We also plan on conducting medical missions, youth group meetings, marriage counseling services, as well as other events and activities that will further the gospel of Jesus Christ. We will soon be offering streaming online presentations and classes at the church community center on subjects like marriage relations, parenting skills, family health, diabetes prevention and care, as well as other subjects of interest to the community. As things progress at the center, we will also be offering youth-targeted programs. Our outreach to the community will encompass basic needs, as well. We will endeavor to have a consistent supply of food and clothing available for families facing desperate circumstances.

The mission work radiating from the center will also focus on community relations with other local organizations, such as battered women's shelters and addiction centers. In this same vein, we have cultivated relationships with medical and dental professionals in the area who are willing to work with us, opening additional resources for care for the poverty-stricken, as well as assistance with future medical missions.




