# Greeting Church


The children at Casa continue to grow and excel both spiritually and academically... We are gratified to report that our








### The Vaughn Graham Education Center

Previously referred to as the west wing, is largely completed except for a few minor items which will be finished soon. We currently have a church group from Colorado working on finishing the "pallet walls" that adorn the wing. These "pallet walls" are rough-cut wood used to create shiplap-type accent walls. The wood that is being re-purposed for these walls was originally part of the old roof trusses in that wing. These accent walls were begun by two of the church groups who visited this summer, and are now being brought closer to completion by the current group. The walls are beautiful, and they are also a beautiful example of churches and people working together toward the same goal.

CHURCH BUILDING




